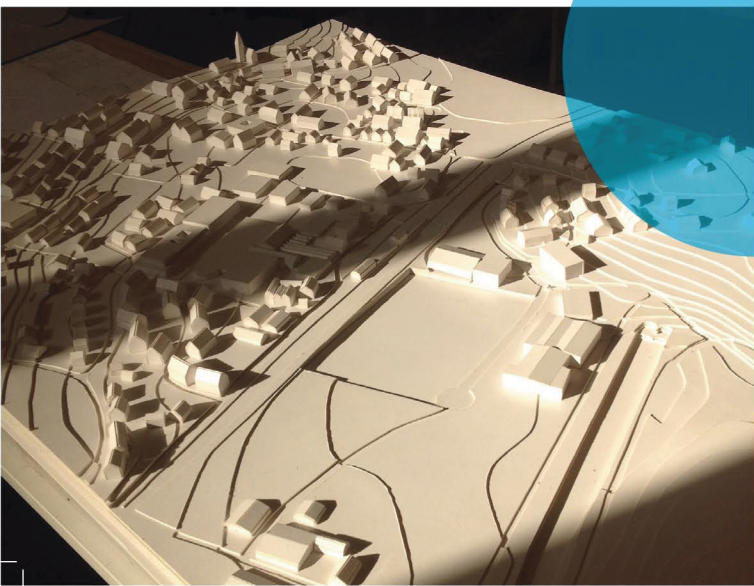

## EDUCATION OBJECTIVES

The MSc in Territorial, Urban, Landscape and Environmental Planning, aims to train specialists capable of designing and managing planning processes at municipal level and urban projects, according to principles of ecological and environmental sustainability and consistent with the criteria of feasibility and legality which must distinguish administrative activity. It provides tools for monitoring and evaluating policies, programmes, plans and projects regarding the territory and the cities, and provide adequate technical support to the definition of lines, documents and strategic plans by institutions and enterprises, in relation to urban policies and development and cohesion programmes, including initiatives and funding from the European Union.



## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The admission to the MSc presupposes the possession of a Bachelor's Degree (three years). It is also possible to register if in possession of other MSc, taking advantage of a reduced course of study, generally only one year, with a study plan based on personal education level.

## WORK OPPORTUNITIES

MSc graduated in Territorial, Urban, Landscape and Environmental Planning possesses the skills required for management, evaluation, planning and the preparation of spatial planning implementation documents, public and private planning documents in authorities of every level. He/she carries out its activity both with public authorities and private organisations and in the field of professionals. He/she has access both to the State Exam to become Planner (Professional Order of Architects), both to the State Exam to become Doctor in Agronomy and Forestry.

## POST-GRADUATION OFFER

The multifaceted qualities and skills of MSc in Territorial, Urban, Landscape and Environmental Planning allow a wide range of fields of specialisation at the main European university institutions. These include the Specialisation Course (Level 2) in Forensic planning offered by the same department.

## THE LOCATION

The centre of didactic and scientific activities is in Via Forno Vecchio, 36, headquarters of the Department of Architecture, near the station of Metro Line 2 (Montesanto station) and Metro Line 1 (Piazza Dante station). The complex is also accessible from Via Toledo and by other public transport.
