The graduate in “Scienze dell’Architettura” can work in public or private companies, engineering firms and architectural offices, construction companies, collaborating in all phases of the building process and developing all the professional activities permitted by the current legislation. Passing the professional qualification exam, the graduate can be enrolled in the Register of Architects, in the section B as a junior architect and can work as professional or be engaged in consultancy activities.
